ITINERARY

DAY 1 – TRAVEL TO DENMARK

Wheels up, our Nordic adventure begins. Let the anticipation build — Christmas lights, cozy cafés, and Danish hygge are waiting to welcome us. Sleep, dream, and get ready to hit the streets of Copenhagen in style.

DAY 2 – LAND TOUR START DAY: COPENHAGEN

Hello Copenhagen! Step off the plane and into a city dressed in festive cheer. Our Copenhagen Discover Card provides us with an airport transfer whisking us straight to the heart of Copenhagen, unlocking four days of seamless exploration. By evening, the magic truly begins at Tivoli Gardens' Christmas Market. Stroll through twinkling lights, enjoying thrilling rides, and feasting on festive treats before settling into a welcome dinner amid the sparkling holiday wonderland. The scent of cinnamon, roasting almonds, and mulled wine is irresistible — our first taste of Danish hygge.

DAY 3 – COPENHAGEN

Wake up ready to explore with a local guide, who will show us Copenhagen's iconic sights. Feel the city hum as we weave through historic streets, colorful waterfronts, and hidden alleys. For lunch, embrace the city's street food scene — grab a smørrebrød, a hot dog, or a creative snack from one of the bustling food halls (on our own). Afterward, we go to the Carlsberg Brewery for a tasting and behind-the-scenes stories of this iconic Danish beer. As evening falls, let the city's festive spirit guide us on a Christmas Market crawl: starting at Højbro Plads, snapping photos at Nyhavn's canals, and sipping gløgg at the Hans Christian Andersen Market. Danish pastries, mulled wine, and twinkling lights — it's a feast for the senses and our Instagram feed.

DAY 4 – COPENHAGEN

Today is all about independent adventure, and our Copenhagen Discover Card gives us the key to exploring the city on our own terms. We can channel our inner Shakespeare at Kronborg Castle in Helsingør, the legendary setting of Hamlet, wandering the ramparts where history and drama collide. If modern art and seaside views call, visit the Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, enjoying cutting-edge exhibits paired with stunning vistas over the Øresund. History buffs among us can dive into royal stories at Rosenborg Castle, home to the Crown Jewels, or climb the Round Tower for panoramic city views. To soak up Copenhagen’s vibrant city life, spend the afternoon wandering Strøget, the bustling shopping street filled with quirky boutiques, Danish design, and inviting cafés. As evening falls, the city’s nightlife comes alive: we gather for dinner in the Meatpacking District (Kødbyen), where creative cuisine and lively energy give us a true taste of Copenhagen. Later, explore local bars, breweries, or a live music venue—savoring craft beer or dancing to the rhythm of the city as we make the most of our farewell evening.
