INTRODUCTION

The AESU Team is ready to help you plan your next fun adventure. Most European countries have eliminated travel restrictions relating to Covid-19, however there are a few countries where it is still mandatory to provide Covid-19 vaccination or recovery certificates.

AESU's commitment to our guests' safety, comfort and well-being while traveling with us has not changed since 1977. With that in mind, AESU has enhanced on-trip protocols and safety procedures so you can continue to travel with confidence. We appreciate your support with these new procedures.

Our travelers' wellbeing is always a top priority, and to deliver a seamless travel experience, we highly recommend that all travelers booked with AESU be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 to travel with us (see www.cdc.gov for guidelines including booster). Regardless of status, travelers must comply with vaccine/booster requirements by airlines and the countries they visit. No refunds are given if traveler cannot complete any portion of the trip due to failure to meet them. This policy is subject to change at any time, without notice.

We want everyone who travels with AESU to have the best experience possible and feel that recommending all travelers to be vaccinated is the most responsible choice. In addition, this policy will also protect the communities we visit.

Please check your destination's entry requirements, as well as requirements for accessing restaurants and venues to ensure that you're prepared for your journey. Guidelines are subject to change at any time.

Here is a quick rundown of what you can expect when traveling with AESU, including guidance from local governments, the World Travel & Tourism Council, US Center for Disease Control (CDC), and the World Health Organization (WHO). Please keep in mind that protocols will be updated if necessary.

Most European countries have done away with requirement to complete a health screening questionnaire. Upon arrival, your tour director will go over current safety practices for your trip.

INCLUDING TRANSPORTATION, HOTELS, AND RESTAURANTS

All local suppliers including hotels, restaurants, transportation companies, and activity providers are enhancing disinfectant protocols for your added safety.

All vehicles undergo rigorous daily cleaning. All hotels are vetted to ensure they meet or exceed government-mandated standards of cleanliness and service.

All rooms are based on double or single occupancy and have en-suite bathrooms.
