| ZAGREB | Zagreb 360 Degree Observation Deck and Bar See the city from another perspective, 16 floors above street level! The observation deck offers birds-eye-views of the main square, Cathedral, Upper and Lower Town, and other cultural and historical architecture of Zagreb. Don't forget your camera, the views are incredible both day and night! | \$ Hours: 10:00 am – 10:00 pm; closes early on Thurs. and Fri. Location: In the heart of Zagreb. |
| | Gornji Grad and the Church of St. Mark's Take a leisurely stroll through the streets Gornji Grad, or Upper Town, lined with amazing, medieval architecture and churches. Along your way, stop to admire the Church of St. Mark's, recognizable by its brightly painted roof. Inside, you can find beautiful statues and murals. | FREE Hours: 7:15 am – 7:00 pm; access may be restricted during certain times Location: Zagreb's main square. |
| | The Art Pavillion and Mestrovic Gallery This art pavilion was originally built for the international exhibition in Budapest in 1896 before finding its home in Zagreb and is now home to bright yellow walls and rotating exhibits. The Mestrovic Gallery is housed in the old home of Ivan Mestrovic, and displays 300 sculptures, made of wood, stone and bronze, as well as other works by the esteemed artist. | \$ Hours: 11:00 am – 8:00 pm; open late on Fridays Location: Accessible by Trams 2, 4, 6, 9, 13 to Glavni kolodvor. |
| SPLIT | Split's Market – Pazar Browse stalls selling everything from fresh fruits and vegetables to wine, clothes and toys in this huge market under the shadow of Diocletian's Palace. Try your hand at bargaining or just enjoy the electric atmosphere and delicious aromas. | FREE Hours: 6:30 am – evening Location: Next to the east wall of Diocletian's Palace and around the church of St Dominic. |
| | Bacvice Beach Take time to relax on the beach, just minutes from the center of town! Soak up some sun and enjoy the Adriatic views with your feet in the sand at this "city-beach." | FREE Hours: Accessible 24/7! Location: Just steps from the center of Split. |
| | Taste fresh seafood at a local cafe Split is known for fresh, local seafood and it is not hard to tell why! Around every corner you will find a café with delicious food to try. | \$ – \$\$ Hours: Restaurant times will vary Location: Located throughout the center of Split. |

The cable cars run day and night and offer some of the best views of the city.</p> | <p>\$ Hours: 9:00 am – 12:00 am; hours change seasonally – refer to timetable Location: About a 10 minute walk around the city walls from the center of Old Town, or take the stairs up Stradun towards Buža gate.</p> |
| | <p>Coast-side Cafes Dubrovnik is home to countless coast-side cafes offering traditional fare and fine wine. Take your time with a leisurely meal and enjoy your food with a view!</p> | <p>\$ – \$\$ Hours: Restaurant times will vary Location: Throughout Dubrovnik, along the Adriatic coast.</p> |
