CAPE TOWN	<b>Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden</b> Allow yourself to get lost in the 89 acres of the Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens. These gardens house more than 7,000 indigenous species of colorful plant life – many rare or endangered. As you are perusing the gardens, be sure to keep an eye out for some of the stunning sculptures scattered throughout the grounds.	<b>\$</b> <b>Hours:</b> 8:00 am - 7:00 pm September - March; 8:00 am - 6:00 pm April - August. <b>Location:</b> Rhodes Dr, Newlands, Cape Town
	<b>District 6 Museum</b> When District 6 was declared a “white” neighborhood in 1966 during the apartheid regime, over 60,000 inhabitants were forcibly removed and relocated. The District 6 museum memorializes these displaced citizens with exhibits that recount their stories and inform visitors about social justice. While it is described as a somber visit, you cannot understand Cape Town’s history without District 6 as a reference point.	<b>\$</b> <b>Hours:</b> 9:00 am - 4:00 pm, booking required. <b>Location:</b> 25A Buitenkant Street, Cape Town 8001
JOHANNESBURG	<b>Constitution Hill</b> Formerly a prison that detained well-known activists like Mohandas Gandhi and iconic anti-apartheid leader Nelson Mandela, Constitution Hill provides fascinating insight into South Africa’s history. Explore the Women’s Gaol, the Old Fort and Number Four – three former prisons that were used to separately house female, white and black political prisoners until 1987.	<b>\$</b> <b>Hours:</b> 9:00 am - 5:00 pm <b>Location:</b> 11 Kotze Road, Johannesburg
	<b>Maboneng Precinct</b> Filled with funky restaurants, cafes, art galleries, shops, hotels and entertainment venues, the Maboneng Precinct is an eclectic neighborhood that truly showcases the best of Old and New Johannesburg.
