LONDON	<b>British Museum</b> The British Museum houses the world's greatest collection of antiquities from ancient Greece, Rome and Asia. Wander through at your own pace with an audio guide, or join a live tour. 	<b>Coca-Cola London Eye</b> As well as being one of the most visually striking structures in the world – the London Eye offers you a new perspective on a great city. Right on the banks of River Thames, across from Big Ben, ride one of the largest ferris wheels in the world for a bird's eye view of London. 	<b>Globe Theatre</b> Reconstructed exactly as it would have been during the time of Shakespeare, this theater is a replica of the original Globe. Catch a show or take a tour of the building. **Tate Modern Viewing Level**
