ITINERARY

DAY 1 - TRAVEL TO LONDON

Embark on your overnight journey to London. Flight not included in tour price.

DAY 2 - LONDON

Passengers to arrive in London this morning (or see below for optional pre-tour program). Transfer on your own to the hotel and check in. In the afternoon, the group will gather in the hotel bar for a welcome and introductions led by History Department faculty, and then walk together to the Churchill War Rooms. This evening enjoy a truly special opportunity, with a private group at the Churchill War Rooms, including a one hour guided tour of the museum, wine, and dinner in the Harmsworth Room.

Inclusions: Welcome orientation and private dinner event

Day 3 - LONDON

After breakfast at the hotel this morning, meet your group in the hotel lobby for a short walk to the Imperial War Museum. Entrance to the museum and a guided tour are included. The afternoon is free to explore London on your own, using your included Travelcard for transport by bus or subway to most destinations within central London.

Day 4 - LONDON TO BAYEUX

Enjoy a boxed breakfast on board the bus as we bid farewell to London. The group will check out of hotel this morning and board a private motorcoach for the drive to Portsmouth. Ohio State History Department staff will give some historical background with a lecture en route. Then board the ferry for a crossing of the English Channel. Upon arrival in France, transfer by private motorcoach to Bayeux and check into the hotel for a stay of four nights. Tonight's group dinner will be at a cozy local restaurant in Bayeux.

Inclusions: Breakfast, Transfer to Portsmouth, Lecture by OSU faculty, One-way ferry crossing, Transfer to Bayeux, Group dinner

Day 5 - BAYEUX

Breakfast is included at the hotel. Then it's a full day of sightseeing in Normandy, with visits to Caen and Pegasus Bridge, followed by a stop in Arromanches to view the Arromanches 360 Cinema. There will be time for lunch on your own in Arromanches, before continuing to the D-Day Museum in the afternoon. Later today, return to Bayeux and visit the Bayeux Commonwealth War Cemetery. An optional evening tour of the Bayeux Tapestry is also possible. Dinner is on your own this evening.

ITINFRARY

Day 6 - BAYEUX

After breakfast at the hotel this morning, another full day of sightseeing in Normandy is on the schedule, with visits to Utah Beach and the Musee du Debarquement, as well as Angoville-au-Plain and Ste-Mere-Eglise. Enjoy lunch on your own in picturesque Ste-Mere-Eglise. In the afternoon, continue sightseeing with a visit to the Musee Airborne and the German Cemetery at La Cambe. Dinner is on your own in Bayeux this evening.

Inclusions: Breakfast, Full day sightseeing with entrances to Musee du Debarquement and Musee Airborne

Day 7 - BAYEUX

Breakfast is at the hotel this morning, and then it's the final day of Normandy sightseeing. Today's itinerary includes Pointe du Hoc and Omaha Beach. The group will enjoy lunch together near Omaha Beach. Continue sightseeing this afternoon with a visit to the Normandy American Military Cemetery. The evening is free and dinner is on your own in Bayeux.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Inclusions: Breakfast, Lunch, Full day sightseeing

Day 8 - BAYEUX TO PARIS

After breakfast at the hotel this morning, check out and depart by private motorcoach for a transfer to Paris, the City of Light. After a quick stop at the hotel to store luggage, the group will tour the Shoah Holocaust Memorial. Later this afternoon, check in to the hotel for a stay of two nights. Dinner is on your own and the evening is free to explore this lovely city.

Inclusions: Breakfast, Transfer to Paris, Shoah Memorial tour

Day 9 - PARIS

Breakfast is included at the hotel. Then meet your local expert tour guide for a walking tour of Wartime Paris. Lunch is on your own, and the afternoon is free, giving you a chance to use the included Paris Museum Pass to explore any of the world-famous museums in the city. Tonight's farewell dinner will be held at a classic Parisian restaurant.

PROGRAM ACCOMMODATIONS

HOTELS

Our hotels are four or five star properties which are among the best in each city. All rooms will have private bath facilities. Hotels are centrally located with easy access to public transportation. Many have extra amenities such as pools, gyms and roof-top bars. All land package rates are based on two people sharing a room. If traveling alone, a single supplement of \$2,150 will apply.



ACTIVITY LEVEL 2: MODERATE

Standing and walking for moderate periods of time during country-side excursions or city tours. Walking typically on flat to moderate terrain; stairways, sometimes without handrails; elevators sometimes available. Appropriate for travelers in good health with overall good mobility, and who are comfortable participating in at least three hours of activity per day.

Please Note:

Travel to and from the tour is not factored into our activity level ratings. You should take into account your stamina when traveling long distances and/or with multiple flight changes. Also, you must be able to handle your luggage independently throughout the itinerary.

TOUR DIRECTOR

Your trip includes the services of a private tour director for the duration of the land tour. All service charges and local taxes are included. Thank your tour director with a gratuity at the end of the tour (suggested amount \$4-5 per day.)

He or she will do their very best to make this trip the most memorable and best time of your life.



OPTIONAL PRE-TOUR EXCURSION

Passengers arriving in London on July 9 or earlier may participate in an optional pre-tour program to Bletchley Park, home of the Ultra Codebreakers. If you've seen "The Imitation Game," you'll want to see this site!

2 nights in first-class hotel * Full breakfast daily at hotel * One day London Travelcards for July 10 * Round trip economy class transportation by train from London to Bletchley * Entrance to Bletchley Park 9 * Accompaniment by Ohio State Faculty

COST: \$687 per person, based on two people sharing a room. Single room supplement: \$490.

BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

EXCLUSIONS: These prices do not include flights; passport and, if applicable, visa fees (Depending on your nationality, you may require visas in addition to a passport to enter certain countries. You must contact appropriate consulates for details on how to obtain on your own.); airport and government taxes; tipping of tour guide and driver (suggested \$4-5 per day for tour director, \$2-3 per day for driver); beverages with meals unless indicated otherwise; laundry; personal insurance; room service; telephone charges; all items of a personal nature; airport transfers; and all items not specifically stated in the itinerary.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All cancellations must be received by AESU in writing. All cancellations for any reason whatsoever will be subject to a \$300 per person cancellation fee. Date of receipt will determine penalties assessed. In addition to \$300, cancellation between 180-91 days of departure will result in forfeiture of 25% of tour cost; between 90-75 days 40%; between 74-30 days 50%; between 29-14 days 80%. Cancellation within 14 days of departure or a "no-show" at the time of departure will result in forfeiture of the entire cost of the trip. AIRFARES are highly restrictive, NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-ENDORSABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE once ticketed. Once reservation is booked and paid for AESU reserves the right to issue tickets. Once ticketed, airfare portion is non-refundable. Cancellation of airfare reservations is subject to restrictions, regulations and additional penalties of the airlines used. Reservation changes are also subject to penalties. Medical health and accident insurance is compulsory. PLEASE SEE WEBSITE FOR POSSIBLE ADDITIONS TO CANCELLATION POLICIES LISTED ABOVE DEPENDING ON TRIP DESTINATION.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS & BAGGAGE: Airport transfers are not included in the tour cost. Many shuttle services are available as well as taxi or train options, or AESU staff will be happy to arrange individual transfers with the hotels at an additional cost. Participants should limit themselves to one checked bag per person and one carry-on per person. Check your airline's website for any additional luggage restrictions. Liability is clearly stated on the passenger contract.

FLIGHT DELAYS/ALL AIRPORTS: As airline delays are beyond the control of AESU, additional expenses, if incurred, will be borne by the tour participant. (Save receipts for possible reimbursement by airline.) AESU is not responsible if an airline cancels, reschedules, or delays a flight for any reason. If you miss your departure flight, it is your responsibility to work with the airline on which you are ticketed to reach your destination. AESU is not responsible for any additional expenses you may incur prior to joining your trip. AESU is not responsible for and will not provide any refund for portions of trips missed due to canceled, rescheduled, or delayed flights. If you purchase your own airfare, book your overnight flight from the USA on July 10, 2020, unless planning to attend optional pre-tour program.

RESPONSIBILITY: The responsibility of AESU as a tour operator, their agents, and any sponsoring association is limited. The right is reserved to decline, to accept or retain any person as a member of the tour or to cancel or alter the tour as required. If improvements in the itinerary can be made, or unforeseen conditions beyond AESU's control make changes necessary, they reserve the right to alter itineraries without penalty. Trip cancellation insurance should be purchased by the individual traveler in the event cancellation of the tour is compelled by circumstances beyond our control. In the event of cancellation due to insufficient number of participants, AESU's liability shall be limited to a FULL REFUND of all payments received from applicants, except non-refundable airfare and insurance. Baggage and personal injury are at owner's risk entirely. The issuance or acceptance of vouchers or tickets shall be considered consent of the above conditions. AESU reserves the right to increase the program price in the event of cost increases due to changes in airfares, currency fluctuations or fuel surcharges. The airlines concerned and their affiliates and agents are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time passengers are not on board the aircrafts.
